

Definitions for Funding Areas

- Access to Higher Education and Continuing Education
 - Access to education beyond high school at a college/university or through postsecondary learning activities and programs.
- Achieve Financial Stability
 - Programs that equip individuals with the knowledge and skills to achieve financial stability and independence and proficiently manage their financial resources.
- Diversity, Equity and Inclusion
 - Programs that promote the fair treatment and full participation of all people, including populations who have historically been underrepresented or subject to discrimination because of their background, identity, disability, etc.
- Early Childhood Education and Childcare
 - Accessible programs that provide education for children outside their own home before kindergarten.
- Education K-12
 - o Pioneering opportunities and solutions that lead to greater student engagement and learning.
- Family/Domestic Violence Resources
 - Resources to inform and strengthen domestic violence intervention and prevention efforts.
- Family Support Programs
 - o Community-based services that assist and support caregivers and children.
- Food & Nutrition Security
 - Physical, social, and economic access to sufficient, safe, and nutritious food that meets their dietary needs and food preferences for an active and healthy life.
- Housing Assistance and Homelessness Resources
 - o Programs that provide safe and affordable housing and homelessness support.
- Mental Health Services
 - Mental health services for the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders.
